Higher education programs include universities, colleges, community colleges, technical schools, trade schools, and vocational schools that award degrees or professional certification. Our scholarship program seeks to provide financial assistance to qualified <u>Non-traditional adult students</u>, giving them an opportunity to better themselves and their families, and in so doing, better our community, while always keeping in mind the Rotary Four Way Test:

- Is it fair to all concerned?
- Will it build goodwill and better friendships?
- Will it be beneficial to all concerned?

General Scholarship Criteria

The Venice-Nokomis Rotary Foundation considers scholarship applications from students of any age who meet **all** the following criteria:

- 1. Permanent legal resident of south Sarasota County.
- 2. Clear financial need, demonstrating that additional funds are needed for further education.
- 3. Attend or plan to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution in a 2-year, 4-year, or graduate degree-seeking program **OR**
- 4. Attend or plan to attend a vocational, technical, or trade school to complete professional certification.

NOTE: Preference will be given to non-traditional students

Application Process

- 2. Required attachments include 1.) Your essay, 2.) Letter of Recommendation, 3.) Unofficial grade transcript, 4.) College/trade school/professional certification acceptance letter if available and 5.) Statement of income for the last fiscal year (W2/Wage income), signed and dated.

- Complete applications must be received by the date noted above.
- Applications received after that date will not be considered.

The Scholarship Committee of the Venice-Nokomis Rotary Foundation will review applications and make recommendations for scholarship finalists. Students selected to receive a Rotary Scholarship Award will be notified, by email on or before June 30th of the current year.

Applying for a scholarship requires the collection of very personal information and the Venice-Nokomis Rotary Foundation will not use this data for any purposes beyond the scholarship review, selection, and award processes. Strict guidelines for maintaining the confidentiality of all scholarship applicants will be followed.

Please answer to the following essay questions on a separate sheet of paper, typed, doublespaced or handwritten. Include your name on all pages.

- 1. Describe yourself. How does your background (family, activities, education, goals, personality) prepare you for college, trade school or professional certification. Include any special or extenuating circumstances that would help or hinder your ability to continue your education, if applicable.
- 2. Describe your ambitions and goals in life. Explain why you wish to continue your education and why you have selected your intended field of study.
- 3. If you plan to return to or stay in south Sarasota County, why would you like to live and work here? If you do not plan to return to this community, please address where you would like to live and why?
